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Report Highlights:

This report complements the FAIRS Annual Country Report for Tanzania and provides information on required certificates for exporting food and agricultural products to the Tanzania mainland. The Government of Tanzania (GoT) uses the Tanzania National Business Portal as a single window for exporters and importers to electronically submit and receive approvals from all regulatory agencies involved in international trade.

Executive Summary:

Tanzania's food regulatory system is generally consistent with the Sanitary and Phytosanitary (SPS) agreement of the World Trade Organization (WTO) and other international treaties including Codex Alimentarius, the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE), and the International Plant Protection Convention (IPPC).

The Tanzania Bureau of Standards (TBS) is responsible for all matters concerning the importation and inspection of imported food products. Regulations guiding the importation of agricultural products are available on the TBS website or Tanzania National Business Portal.

Before shipping to Tanzania, all consignments are subject to <u>pre-shipment verification of conformity (PVoC)</u>. Under the PVoC process, goods are inspected and tested to ensure compliance with relevant standards and specifications before being shipped to Tanzania. At the end of this process goods are issued a Certificate of Conformity (CoC) if they are found to comply with Tanzania's standards. All PVoC-regulated goods must obtain a CoC prior to export, which are issued on a per-consignment basis. A CoC is valid for three months after issuance and TBS may reject consignments covered by a CoC if the shipment is found not to conform with Tanzania standards when it arrives at the port of entry.

Tanzania uses third-party contractors to conduct PVoC inspections. Currently Intertek International, Bureau Veritas, Société Générale de Surveillance (SGS), TUV-Rheinland, and the China Certification and Inspection Group Company Limited (CCIC) are contracted to conduct PVoC inspections in origin countries. CCIC's contract is only valid for inspection in mainland China, Macau, Hong Kong, and Taiwan.

The following activities are conducted during PVoC:

- 1. Physical inspection before shipment.
- 2. Sampling, testing, and analysis in accredited laboratories.
- 3. A quality audit of production processes.
- 4. Documentary review of conformity with regulations.
- 5. Issuance of a CoC or a Non-Conformity Report (NCR) as appropriate.

- 1. An original pro forma invoice from the supplier of goods.
- 2. A bill of lading or airway bill.
- 3. A certificate of analysis of products (original).
- 4. A food security permit.
- 5. A zoo-sanitary certificate (for non-processed food of animal origin).
- 6. A blank certificate of origin depending on the country of origin.
- 7. A certificate of good manufacturing practices.
- 8. Relevant insurance documents.

Additional information is available at the Tanzania National Business Portal.

Tanzania's Meat Board offers <u>clearance certificates</u> for regulating the meat industry market. Additionally, the Veterinary Services Department (DVS) offers import and export permits for controlling animal diseases.
