Report Highlights:

Effective March 1, 2021, the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) requires a certificate for Non-Genetically Modified (GM) and GM-Free status for all apples, all origins being imported into the country. The certificate will be issued by the Washington State Department of Agriculture, in the format prescribed by the FSSAI, as the authorized regional government authority.

GENERAL INFORMATION

On August 21, 2020, the <u>Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI)</u> issued Order, Requirement of Non-GM cum GM Free Certificate Accompanied with Imported Consignment Reg., effective January 1, 2021, mandating a new requirement for all food imported consignments containing any of 24 specific foods:

This trade disruptive, non-science-based order requires that each consignment must now be accompanied by a certificate attesting that the product(s) is of non-Genetically Modified (GM) origin and does not contain genetically modified organisms. The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India specified the requirement of certification by the "competent authority in the exporting country." Following the order's initial publication in August 2020, the FSSAI issued a series of clarifications, including a revised implementation date and permitting certification from regional authorities.

FSSAI issues an order mandating that effective January 1, 2021, specific food
consignments exported to India must include a "non-GM origin and GM free
certificate," issued by the competent authority in the exporting country. The order
applies to all imports of the listed 24 products, regardless of whether genetically
engineered (GE) varieties of those products are in commercial production and/or are
being exported to India, including U.Sorigin apples (i.e., Red Delicious) variety
(see, Appendix $-$ I).
FSSAI clarifies that its order is applicable to only food products listed in Annex-I of
its order and does not apply to processed food products in general (see, Appendix -
II).
FSSAI extends its implementation date of the order to March 1, 2021 (see,
Appendix – III)
FSSAI clarifies that the implementation of its order will apply to all consignments
with a bill of lading dated March 1, 2021. It also informs the permissible tolerance
limit for the adventitious presence of GMOs (GE) at one percent (see, Appendix –
IV).
FSSAI publishes a clarification indicating acceptable certifying authority options.
These include: (1) Non-GM origin cum GM-free attestation on the phytosanitary or
health certificate for each consignment provided all required information and
declaration specified in the FSSAI's order of August 21, 2020, are included or (2)
Non-GM origin cum GM Free Certificate issued by an authorized regional (i.e., state
level) government authority of the exporting country in the specified format (see,
Appendix – V).

WORKAROUND SOLUTION

The <u>Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA)</u>, as an authorized regional government authority, will provide a certificate as per India's FSSAI requirements for the shipment of apples. The certificate will reference as well the federal <u>U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) - Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS)</u> phytosanitary certificate number (see, Appendix - VI) which will continue to be issued as usual.

ORDER

Subject: Requirement of Non-GM cum GM free certificate accompanied with imported food consignment-reg.

Sub-regulation 12(2) of Food Safety and Standards (Import) Regulations, 2017 specifies that "the Food Authority may issue order or advisory or guideline as it deems fit, from time to time for ensuring the safety and wholesomeness of articles of food imported into India and such prohibitions and restrictions shall be informed to the customs immediately".

- 2. In exercise of above said provision, to ensure that only Non GM food crops are imported into India, pending framing of regulations related to Genetically Engineered or Modified as envisaged in section 22 of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006, it has been decided that every consignment of imported food products mentioned in Annexure I shall be accompanied with a Non-GM origin cum GM free certificate as per format of Annexure-II, issued by Competent National Authority of the exporting country.
- This order shall be effective from 1st January, 2021 and this issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
