

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2021

January 2021

The January WASDE report shows FY 2021 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 99,208 short tons raw value (STRV), unchanged from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The third tranche of the FY 2021 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 40,000 metric tons raw value on January 22, 2021. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
