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Report Highlights:

This report outlines The Bahamas' certification requirements and includes an Export Certificate Matrix as well as examples of select Export Certificates.

This report was prepared by the Caribbean Basin Agricultural Trade Office (CBATO) in Miami, Florida, for U.S. exporters of domestic food and agricultural products. While every possible care has been taken in the preparation of this report, information provided may not be completely accurate either because policies have changed since its preparation, or because clear and consistent information about these policies was not available. It is highly recommended that U.S. exporters verify the full set of import requirements with their foreign customers, who are normally best equipped to research such matters with local authorities, before any goods are shipped. Executive Summary

Given The Bahamas' proximity to South Florida and the fact that it imports the vast majority of its food needs from the United States, The Bahamas has historically placed a large degree of trust in U.S. food safety and animal and plant health regulatory systems. Standard sanitary and phytosanitary certificates issued by U.S. Federal regulatory authorities are fully accepted by the Government of The Bahamas. Certificates must be originals and must accompany products at the time of entry. It is recommended that U.S. suppliers have their Bahamian buyer verify compliance with all certification requirements prior to shipping any products to The Bahamas. U.S. Exporters may also refer to The Bahamas Food Agricultural Import Regulations Standards (FAIRS) Country report for more information.

Section II. Purpose of Specific Export Certificate(s)

• Meat and Poultry Export Certificate of Wholesomeness: BAHFSA and the Department of Agriculture's Veterinary Services Unit require this certificate for food quality purposes.

Note: USDA's Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) issues this certificate.

• Sanitary Certificate for Exports (for unprocessed dairy products): BAHFSA and the Department of Agriculture's Veterinary Services Unit require this certificate for food safety/quality purposes and animal health purposes.

Note: USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) issues this certificate.

• Shell Egg Grading Certificate: BAHFSA and the Department of Agriculture's Veterinary Services Unit require this certificate for food safety/quality purposes.

Note: USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) issues this certificate.

• Disease Free Certification Statements for Other Countries: BAHFSA and the Department of Agriculture's Veterinary Services Unit require this certificate for animal health purposes.

Note: USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) issues this certificate.

• Phytosanitary Certificate: This certificate is required by the Ministry of Agriculture and Marine Resources Plant Protection Office for plant protection purposes.

Note: USDA's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) is the principal U.S. Federal Agency responsible for issuing Phytosanitary Certificates.

• Export Health Certificate (for unprocessed seafood): This certificate is required by BAHFSA for food safety purposes.

Note: This certificate is issued by the National Marine Fisheries Service, a dependency of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) of the U.S. Department of Commerce.

Section III. Specific Attestations Required on Export Certificate(s)

For most certificates, no additional attestations are required. The attestations made on the standard forms of the certificates are acceptable. One exception to this may be the Phytosanitary Certificate. The exact attestation required, which will be outlined in the import permit that must be obtained by the importer in advance of the shipment, may vary depending on the nature of the product and phytosanitary conditions in the country of origin. The following sample attestation is meant as a guideline only:

"The products have been inspected and/or tested according to appropriate official procedures and are considered to be free from pests and diseases and conform to the current phytosanitary requirements of The Bahamas."

Another exception may be the Export Health Certificate (for unprocessed seafood). BAHFSA will make a determination on any additional requirements in this regard.

Section IV. Government Certificate's Legal Entry Requirements

As a general rule, The Bahamas Government requires that all certificates be issued by a U.S. Federal Agency. The Government will not accept U.S. State-issued certificates or manufacturer/supplier's export declarations as proof of compliance. Customs Officials will accept the certificates for the indicated shipment only, and an original certificate must accompany the products at the time of entry.

It is important to note that The Bahamas is preparing to integrate electronic phytosanitary certificates (ePhytos) by January 2021. Currently a phytosanitary certificate is required to accompany every consignment of imported plants and plant products. By accepting ePhytos, which would be received even prior to the consignment's arrival at a port of entry, The Bahamas expects to expedite imports even further.

Section V. Other Certification/Accreditation Requirements to Ensure Market Entry

U.S. suppliers should work closely with their Bahamian importer to ensure that they are in full compliance with the latest certification requirements and other specified conditions of entry.
