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Report Highlights:

This FAIRS-Côte d'Ivoire Export Certificate Report Annual - 2025, highlights the certificates and permits that the Ivorian government requires for the import of U.S.-origin food and agricultural products into Côte d'Ivoire. This report compliments the FAIRS-CÔTE D'IVOIRE | IV2025-0010 | Côte d'Ivoire Country Report Annual - 2025. FAS Abidjan, Accra, (Post) recommends that prospective U.S. exporters familiarize themselves with these reports for a better understanding of Ivorian food and agricultural standards, export certifications, and permit requirements.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Côte d'Ivoire requires specific export certificates for the import of food and agricultural products. The Ivorian government, for example requires official export certificates for multiple products, including for plants, fruits, and vegetables, live animals, day-old chicks, hatching eggs, meat and meat products, and fish and fish products. These certificates are for sanitary, phytosanitary, and food safety purposes

For certain products, a request for plant imports must be submitted to the Ivorian Directorate of Plant Protection prior to shipment for phytosanitary approval. Côte d'Ivoire only accepts original certificates, which should accompany the consignment product at the time of entry. These certificates cannot be applied to multiple shipments. Only certificates issued by a competent authority are acceptable. Côte d'Ivoire does not apply waivers for export certificates.

All U.S. federally inspected establishments are eligible to export to Côte d'Ivoire. The latest information is available at FSIS Export Library entry for Côte d'Ivoire. Complete import requirements and copies of the certificates are available on the APHIS website.

SECTION III: GOVERNMENT CERTIFICATE LEGAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

U.S. exporters should work with a registered and established representative or distributor, or register directly their company before starting to ship, as the regulations require. All certificates listed in this report must accompany the product at the time of entry and must be original. A certificate cannot be applied to multiple shipments and Côte d'Ivoire does not accept a Supplier's or Manufacturer's Export Declaration as proof of compliance in place of a certificate issued by a competent authority.

Côte d'Ivoire does not require a Certificate of Free Sale but does accept U.S. state-issued export certificates. All relevant certificates must be from a competent authority. Côte d'Ivoire does not waive export certificates. Côte d'Ivoire's one-stop-shop for registrations developed by the [Ivorian Investment Promotion Center \(CEPICI\)](#), coordinates and assist with registration process.¹

SECTION IV: OTHER CERTIFICATION/ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENTS TO ENSURE MARKET ENTRY

The Directorate of Veterinary Services of Côte d'Ivoire, under the supervision of the Ministry of Animal Resources and Fisheries, carries out sanitary inspections and certifications to ensure food safety.

Veterinary Sanitary Requirements and Certificates

This certificate is for animal health purposes, attesting to:

- Animals are healthy and come from a farm free from any recognized contagious disease as per standards established by the Terrestrial Animal Health Code of the World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH).

In Côte d'Ivoire, business creation and investment promotion is primarily managed by two agencies; the *Centre de Facilitation des Formalités des Entreprises* (CFE) and the Ivorian Investment Promotion Center (*Centre de Promotion des Investissements en Côte d'Ivoire* or CEPICI). The CFE is dedicated to streamlining the process of business start-up, aiming to accomplish registration within 48-hours. On the other hand, CEPICI focuses on supporting joint-venture operations and investments within the country. Operating as a "one-stop shop" in Abidjan, CEPICI offers guidance to foreign investors and simplifies the business registration process, reducing bureaucratic hurdles. - Hatching eggs were disinfected under official veterinary supervision, and they come from farms where vaccination against listed contagious diseases has been provided.
- Animals come from a region not officially declared infected with contagious disease for more than six weeks.
- Animals come from farms regularly inspected by an authorized veterinary officer.
- Animals are immunized against Rinderpest and Contagious Bovine Peri pneumonia (CBPP) for more than 10 days or come from disease-free areas for six (6) months.
- Animals of bovine species, their ova and embryos, fresh meat (bone or deboned) and products derived from cattle meat, meal meat and bone meal, and any animal feed derived do not originate from a country where *bovine spongiform encephalopathy* (BSE) has been reported.
- Sheep and goats are immunized with a live vaccine against Rift Valley Fever or *Peste des Petits Ruminants* (PPR) or come from disease-free zones.
- Canine and feline animals should be accompanied by an International Rabies Vaccination Certificate dated no less than fifteen (15) days or more than one-year.
- Animals of avian species (non-poultry) that have or have not been vaccinated against listed infectious diseases. For vaccinated animals, the date of vaccination and the nature of the vaccine used should be specified.
- Bovine, ovine, porcine, and equine semen, ova, or embryos come from healthy donors according to standards set by the Terrestrial Animal Health Code for each disease.

The importer must submit a phytosanitary certificate issued by the competent authority of the country of export to the Ministry of Agriculture border inspectors. If approved, border inspectors will give a phytosanitary certificate issued by the Ivorian government, which is required for importation. The following products – regardless of the type of preservation used (chilling, freezing, cooking, salting) – will be checked for safety (organoleptic, micro-biological etc.,) before being allowed entry into Côte d'Ivoire's territory:

- Meat (pork, sheep, beef, horse) and poultry meat
- Ground meat
- Cooked meat
- Meat products (sausages, ham etc.,)
- Prepared meals
- Dehydrated soups
- Organ meats and offal (e.g., liver, heart, leg, and head of pigs, sheep, cattle, and horse; liver, heart, gizzard, and rump of poultry)
- Eggs and egg products, pastries, custards
- Fermented or acidified milk, fermented milk curds (yogurt, kefir), milk jelly, milk powder, cheese, fresh pasteurized cream, ice cream, casein, butter, and margarine
- Canned food made from animal products or originating from animals
- Semi-preserved foods made from animal products or originating from animals

- Milk intended for heat treatment or processing
- Honey and wax
- Canned vegetables
- Hides and skins
- Meat meal and poultry meal, feathers
- Animal fat
- Fish and seafood products

For all imported food and agricultural products, the importer or local agent must submit a final invoice or pro forma invoice, certificate of origin, a prior import declaration (DPI), and an applicable import certificate (issued by the border inspector) to the Director of the Division of Consumption and Quality of the Ministry of Commerce, and Promotion of Small-Medium Enterprises (SMEs) to receive an approved Import Declaration for Food Products (DIPA). A DIPA is required to legally import any food or agricultural product and initiate the customs clearance process. The DIPA is valid for two months from the date of signature.

All agricultural and plant related products can only be introduced in Côte d'Ivoire with the approval of the Directorate of Plant Protection Service (DPV). For fresh meat, chilled or frozen milk, and their derivatives, an analysis showing the presence or absence of residues of antibiotics, artificial radionuclide, anabolic hormone, or any other contaminant that may constitute a threat to public health is required.²

A non-radioactivity certificate and a certificate of non-contamination of dioxin are only required for milk powder.

² While agricultural products are admitted through phytosanitary certificate and health certificate, genetically engineered (GE) products are not yet allowed. FSIS Meat and Poultry Export Certificate of Wholesomeness³

According to the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995, an agency may not conduct or sponsor, and a person is not required to respond to, a collection of information unless it displays a valid OMB control number. The valid OMB control number for this information collection is 0583-0153. The time required to complete this information collection is estimated to average 25 minutes per response, including the time for reviewing instruction, searching existing data sources, gathering and maintaining the data needed, and completing and reviewing the collection of information.
