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# Report Name: Eurasian Economic Commission Published 2021 TRQs

Country: Russian Federation

**Report Category:** Trade Policy Monitoring, Livestock and Products, Poultry and Products, Dairy and Products

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## **Report Highlights:**

On August 18, 2020, the Eurasian Economic Commission (EEC) issued Decision No. 102, establishing tariff-rate quotas (TRQs) and respective volumes for imports of meat, poultry, and whey into the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU). In line with the WTO commitments, Russia's TRQ volumes will remain unchanged from 2020. TRQ volumes for Belarus, Kazakhstan and the Kyrgyz republic will also be the same as in 2020, while Armenia will have TRQs for beef, pork, poultry and whey in 2021, for the first time since its EAEU accession in 2015.

#### **General Information**

On August 18, 2020, the Eurasian Economic Commission (EEC) issued <u>Decision No. 102</u>, "On Establishment of Tariff-Rate Quotas for Import of Certain Agricultural Goods into the Customs Territory of the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU<sup>1</sup>) in 2021, as well as Volumes of Tariff-Rate Quotas for Import of these Goods in the Territories of the Eurasian Economic Union Member States."

Following replacement of the Russian pork TRQs with a 25 percent flat rate for imported pork in 2020, the Russian 2021 TRQ volumes for remaining products, namely beef, poultry and whey, will be the same as in 2020, which is consistent with Russia's World Trade Organization (WTO) commitments. As in the previous years, the EEC Decision on 2021 TRQs does not specify country-specific allocations for Russia but rather leaves it up to the country to ensure distribution of the tariff-rate quotas established by the Decision among third countries in accordance with the Russian legislation and Russia's WTO commitments.

The 2021 TRQ volumes for Belarus, Kazakhstan and the Kyrgyz Republic will remain the same as in 2020, while Armenia, in a change from the previous years, will have TRQs in 2021, for the first time since its EAEU accession in 2015. In particular, Armenia's 2021 TRQ for beef will be 6 thousand metric tons (MT), for pork – 10 thousand MT, for poultry – 44 thousand MT, and whey – 500 MT.

The unified EAEU in-quota tariff rate to be applied by Armenia since 2021 for frozen beef is 15 percent, and for poultry - 25 percent but not less than 0.2 Euro per kilogram. At the same time, according to Armenia's amended transitional import tariffs in EAEU<sup>2</sup>, its out-of-quota tariff for imported frozen beef is set to increase from 12.5 percent in 2020 to 25 percent in 2021, while Armenia's out-of-quota tariff for imported poultry will go up from 22 percent in 2020 to 50 percent in 2021. At that, Armenia's out-of-quota tariffs for both products in 2021 will still be lower than the unified EAEU tariff, which is 50 percent but not less than 1 Euro per kilogram for frozen beef and 80 percent but not less than 0.7 Euro per kilogram for poultry. Armenia is currently scheduled to increase its frozen beef and poultry out-of-quota import tariff to the level of the unified EAEU tariff as of 2022.

The TRQ allocations announced by the above Decision No. 102 will enter into force as of September 20, 2020.

#### On Establishment of Tariff-Rate Quotas for Import of Certain Agricultural Goods into the Customs Territory of the Eurasian Economic Union in 2021, as well as Volumes of Tariff-Rate Quotas for Import of these Goods in the Territories of the Eurasian Economic Union Member States

In accordance with articles 44 and 45 of the Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Union of May 29, 2014, Annexes No. 6 and 7 to the stated Treaty, and the Agreement on the Functioning of the Customs Union within the Framework of the Multilateral Trade System of May 19, 2011, the Collegium of the Eurasian Economic Commission has **decided**:

1. For certain types of agricultural goods, imported into the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union in 2021, to establish tariff-rate quotas and distribute volumes of tariff-rate quotas for the import of these goods in the territories of the Eurasian Economic Union Member States according to the attachment (hereinafter – the tariff-rate quotas).

2. To establish that the tariff-rate quotas shall apply to agricultural goods imported into the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union and placed under the customs procedure of release for domestic consumption, with the exception of goods originating in and imported from the CIS Member States.

3. The Russian Federation shall ensure distribution of the volume of the tariff-rate quotas among third countries in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation and commitments of the Russian Federation within the framework of the World Trade Organization.

4. Eurasian Economic Union Member States shall:

Implement distribution of the volumes of the tariff-rate quotas among foreign trade participants in accordance with their legislation;

Instruct the authorized executive bodies to issue licenses for the import of goods, specified in item 1 of the present Decision.

5. This Decision shall enter into force 30 calendar days from the date of its official publication.
