Section IV. Government Certificate's Legal Entry Requirements

The original certificates must accompany the imported product at the time of entry. The import license for live animals and animal products should have already been obtained before shipments arrive. An insurance certificate should also be available at hand with shipments. Certificate of country of origin is a required document that is used as a supporting document to obtain import permits from MAFF. There is no fee or charge for the import license. However, a service charge is levied to cover the cost of the sanitary inspection and a fee will be charged for laboratory tests.

Doing Business on Collected Buying Live Animal and Products of Origin

I commit to the \Box Department of Live Animal and Production, \Box Office of Live Animal and Production that I shall:

- Not buy illegal products of origin from neighbor countries.
- Transportation products of origin are local products.
- All transportation of products of origin meets completed dossiers and validity.
- All transportation of products of origin shall have sanitary certificate and services charges of sanitary issued by the authority of live animal and production at the first point.

- All transportation of products of origin shall respect to the guidelines and permitted letter for transporting products of origin.
- Providing good conditions to authority to inspect sanitary of live animal and products of origin.
- All means and tools for packaging live animal and products of origin shall assure all quality safety and sanitary during transporting.
- Not sell the rights or provide the rights to other firms or entities beyond the right firm name which is permitted to do business.
