## **Report Name:** FSSAI Publishes List of HS Food Product Codes Requiring Health Certificate

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## **Report Highlights:**

On December 28, 2022, the Government of India's Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) notified on its website No: 1829/Health Certificate/FSSAI/Imports-2021. The notification is in continuation to the FSSAI order from August 3, 2022, requiring all milk and milk products; pork and pork products; and fish and fish products, imported into India to be accompanied with a health certificate issued by the competent authority of the exporting country. The order includes a list of HS codes that a FSSAI health certificate is required for import into India, including new commodities not previously mentioned in the August 3, 2022 order. Additionally, FSSAI advises interested stakeholders to verify the applicability of the listed HS codes in line with the food products specified under the Food Safety and Standards (Food Product Standards and Food Additives) Regulations (2011).

## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

On December 28, 2022, the Government of India's Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) notified on its website File No: 1829/Health Certificate/FSSAI/Imports-2021. The notification is in continuation to the earlier FSSAI order from August 3, 2021, requiring all milk and milk products; pork and pork products; and fish and fish products, imported into India to be accompanied with a health certificate issued by the competent authority of the exporting country in the format published in the FSSAI notification. The order includes a list of harmonized system (HS) codes that a FSSAI health certificate is required for import into India, including new commodities not previously mentioned in the August 3, 2022 order, such as HS Code 02069010, "of sheep and goats." To date, the Order has not been notified to the World Trade Organization.

Additionally, FSSAI advises interested stakeholders to verify the applicability of the listed HS codes in line with the food products specified under the Food Safety and Standards (Food Product Standards and Food Additives) Regulations (2011). All product standards covered under the three categories of products mentioned in the notification will now require health certificates to be accompanied with consignments imported to India. This includes standards under sub-regulation 2.1 for "Milk and Milk Products", sub-regulation 2.5.2(7) for "Pork and Pork Products" and sub-regulation 2.6 for "Fish and Fish Products." FSSAI officials noted to FAS New Delhi that additional commodities (with HS codes) will be added from time to time at FSSAI's discretion.

The HS codes covered for each chapter that require a health certificate for import into India are listed below. Commodities listed in Chapters 2, 3, 4, 15, 16, and 21 are categorized as "High-risk." Conversely, commodities under Chapter 17 are deemed "Low-risk."

Chapter 2: Meat and Edible Meat Offal

- Chapter 3: Fish and Crustaceans, Mollusks, and other Aquatic Invertebrates HS Codes 0302/0303/0304/0305/0306/0307/0308/0309
- Chapter 4: Dairy Produce; Birds' Eggs; Natural Honey; Edible Products of Animal Origin, not elsewhere specified or included HS Codes 0401/0402/0403/0404/0405/0406

- Chapter 15: Animal, Vegetable or Microbial Fats and Oils and their Cleavage Products; Prepared Edible Fats; Animal or Vegetable Waxes HS Codes 1501/1504
- Chapter 16: Preparations of Meat, of Fish, of Crustaceans, Mollusks or other Aquatic Invertebrates, or of Insects HS Codes 1601/1602/1603/1604/1605

Chapter 17: Sugars and Sugar Confectionery HS Codes 1702- Other Sugars, including chemically pure lactose, maltose, glucose and fructose, in solid form, sugar syrups not containing added flavoring or coloring matter; artificial honey, whether or not mixed with natural honey; caramel

**Chapter 21:** Miscellaneous Edible Preparations HS Code 2105 – Ice cream and other edible ice, whether or not containing cocoa
