FSSAI Invites Comments on E-Commerce Regulatory Standards

The draft notification defines the business model of e-commerce FBO and also, specifies regulatory requirements, which include registration and licensing requirements, supply chain compliance requirements, food product listings and information requirements, displaying food products requirements, handling of consumer complains, and responsibility of e-commerce FBOs vis-à-vis recalls. The draft notification also states that all terms, which are not defined in draft notification, shall have the same meaning as defined in Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006.
