Report Highlights:

This report lists certificates required by Thai government agencies for U.S. products exported to Thailand, including 57 processed and unprocessed food items, other prepackaged processed food, fruit and vegetables, live animals, boneless beef, canned or preserved meat and poultry products, other processed meat products, processed or frozen seafood, hides and skins, distillers dried grains, and live animals. The update made in this report is the certificate required for U.S. frozen fruits export to Thailand.

In addition, both the DOA and the DLD require import permits. The procedure for import permit issuance has been, at times, non-transparent for certain pork and poultry products. The DLD agreed in principle (although not officially in writing) to accept "system audits" for exporting facilities instead of its earlier requirement of "separate plant audits." However, the DLD added the requirement that exporting countries of animal and animal products must complete the DLD's questionnaire for approval before the DLD send its team to conduct on-site inspections for each exporting country.




