#### **Czech Republic Specific Required Export Certification**

Exceptions/additions to the EU harmonized certificates include:

#### Pet birds

In addition to an EU harmonized certificate, import of pet birds requires individual authorization from the State Veterinary Administration – applies until December 31, 2015.

#### **Certification of Origin for Spirits Cancelled**

The Government Regulation no. 307/2012 requiring specific certification of origin for certain types of spirits and distillates was cancelled as of September 1, 2014, by the Czech Government. The certificate of origin is no longer required. However, all original legislative requirements are still in place, which means products still have to comply with the food safety and traceability requirements as set by Czech and EU legislation.
