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**Report Highlights:**

The report lists the major export certificates required for food, feed, and agricultural product imports to Myanmar.

**Summary:**

Various Ministries in Myanmar regulate food and agricultural imports. Agricultural products such as plants and plant products, animal and animal products, and feed imports are handled by the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Irrigation (MOALI). Different departments within MOALI regulate these products. All processed food and beverage imports are managed by the Department of Food and Drug Administration (FDA). The following charts list the required export certificates that must come from exporting countries, for different types of products. Regulations and procedures in Myanmar often change suddenly, so companies should work closely with their importers to verify the latest requirements.

#### **Section IV: Government Export Certificate Legal Entry Requirements**




The original Phytosanitary Certificates and Health Certificates must accompany the product. Each certificate can be for a single shipment. Only Myanmar citizens may submit product declarations.

#### **Section V: Other Certification/ Accreditation Requirements to Ensure Market Entry**

If the product is re-exported through a third party country, an additional Phytosanitary certificate will be required by that country. The PC from the country of origin must also accompany the re-export Phytosanitary Certificate.




