On April 5, 2023, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare/Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) issued Notification No. F. No. Std/SP-05/T(IFR-02). The notification was published in the Gazette of India (official gazette) on March 29, 2023, covering the draft amendments to the Food Safety and Standards (Foods for Infant Nutrition) Regulations (2020). Amendments include limit specifications for selenium, iron, biotin, and manganese in infant nutrition foods. World Trade Organization (WTO) members are invited to comment on the proposed draft amendment; the timeline to provide comments is June 24, 2023.

APPENDIX I: FSSAI'S FOOD SAFETY AND STANDARDS (FOODS FOR INFANT NUTRITION) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS, 2023

FOOD SAFETY AND STANDARDS AUTHORITY OF INDIA

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 29th March, 2023

F. No. Std/SP-05/T(IFR-02).—The following draft of certain regulations, further to amend the Food Safety and Standards (Foods for Infant Nutrition) Regulations, 2020, which the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India proposes to make with the previous approval of the Central Government, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (2) of section 92 of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 (34 of 2006), is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) thereof, for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby; and notice is hereby given that the said draft regulations shall be taken into consideration after the expiry of a period of sixty days from the date on which copies of the Official Gazette in which this notification is published are made available to the public.

Objections or suggestions, if any, may be addressed to the Chief Executive Officer, Food Safety and Standards Authority of India, FDA Bhawan, Kotla Road, New Delhi- 110002 or sent on email at regulation @fssai.gov.in.

Objections or suggestions, which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft regulations before the expiry of the period so specified, shall be considered by the Food Authority.

Draft Regulation

- 1. These regulations may be called the Food Safety and Standards (Foods for Infant Nutrition) Amendment Regulations, 2023.
- 2. In the Food Safety and Standards (Foods for Infant Nutrition) Regulations, 2020,-
