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Report Highlights:

On October 8, 2024, the People's Republic of China Food Safety Standards Monitoring and Evaluation Department of the National Health Commission (NHC) released a letter soliciting public comments on nineteen draft National Food Safety Standards. This report contains an unofficial translation of the letter and the list of draft standards. The announcement includes both new and revised national food safety standards covering the general rules for spices, limits for contaminants in foods, sterilized milk, food additives, water and fat content determination in foods, and testing of migration of chemicals in food contact materials and products. Stakeholders should conduct their own review of the regulation. Based on past experience, the PRC often notifies these texts to the WTO after the domestic comment period ends.

Report Summary:

On October 8, 2024, the National Health Commission (NHC) released a "Letter from the Secretariat of the National Food Safety Standard Review Committee on Soliciting Public Comments on Nineteen National Food Safety Standards Including the National Food Safety Standard General Rules for Spices (link in Chinese)."

The draft National Food Safety Standards open for comments include revisions or the new drafts of the following standards:

- Standards of contaminant limits in foods and sterilized milk,
- Six food additives standards,
- Determination of contents of Vitamin C, ash, water, and fat, etc.,
- Chemical migration in food contact materials and products,
- Testing of botulinum toxin.

The written comments for the draft standards in the list can be submitted via the National Food Safety Standards Information Management System (<u>https://sppt.cfsa.net.cn:8086/cfsa_aiguo</u>) (link is in Chinese) by the due date of October 18, 2024.

This report contains an unofficial translation of the announcement letter, and the list of draft standards open for comments in China. Stakeholders should conduct their own review of the regulation. Post expects these draft standards to be notified to WTO after domestic comments period ends.
