**Report Highlights:**

Pursuant to General Administration of Customs of the People's Republic of China (GACC) Department of Animal and Plant Quarantine (DAPQ) requirements, exporters of “pulse crops” such as dried beans, dried peas, and lentils are required to register exporting facilities prior to product shipment. Exporters seeking to register a U.S. facility or update a U.S. facility registration for dried beans, dried peas, and/or lentils sending product to China from the United States are advised to submit a registration request. This report provides information on the process, requirements, current registrations, and points of contact.

## Summary

The GACC DAPQ requires that facilities that export “pulse crops” be registered with GACC prior to product shipment. Information provided in this report is only applicable to U.S. exports of dried beans, dried peas, and lentils for which the United States has market access to China. U.S. facilities and exporters may send questions to the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Foreign Agricultural Service, Office of Agricultural Affairs at the U.S. Embassy in Beijing, China (FAS China). Prior to submitting a registration request, U.S. companies should first check the list of approved U.S. facilities on the GACC website to confirm if the facility is already listed. The current list of U.S. pulse crop facilities registered to export to China can be found at the following link:

After a review of necessary information, detailed below, information and email correspondence will be sent to FAS China at: [FASChinaDAPQRegistrations@usda.gov](mailto:FASChinaDAPQRegistrations@usda.gov).

Information necessary for registration includes:

- 1. Product Type** (i.e., One or more of the following pulse crops like dried beans, peas, and lentils.)
- 2. Facility Registration Number** (i.e., A unique identifying number for the facility that could be disclosed and shared publicly such as a U.S. Food and Drug Administration Firm Establishment Identifier (FEI) or an Internal Revenue Service Employer Identification Number (EIN). Other unique facility registration numbers specific to the industry and the facility that could be published may also be acceptable.)
- 3. Company/Facility Name** (i.e., Name that will be associated with shipment documents and/or any packaging.)
- 4. Facility Address** (i.e., Location of facility from where product will be shipped from and/or documents issued. Note: Be consistent with abbreviations and naming such as “Rd” or “Road,” “St” or “Street,” and “N” or “North”.)

**CAUTION:** Exporters and facilities should ensure consistency as any discrepancies in the above, once listed on the GACC website and when product arrives at a Chinese port and presented for customs clearance, could result in delays or shipment detention.

Upon receipt of the above information, the USA Dry Pea and Lentil Council and American Pulse Association will review the information for completeness and submit the information to FAS China. FAS China will then transmit the information to GACC DAPQ. The length of time it may take GACC DAPQ to update and publish information on its website may vary and FAS China is unable to estimate how long the process may take from submission to publication.

**IMPORTANT:** U.S. exporters are cautioned to not ship products from facilities that are not updated on the GACC DAPQ registered facility list. Only once a facility is listed, should product be shipped. Submitting facility information or updated facility information does not constitute registration with GACC DAPQ.
