TH0173: This report lists certificates required by Thai government agencies for the import of U.S. products into Thailand. These include standardized requirements for 56 processed and unprocessed food items and individual requirements for popcorn, fruit and vegetables, live animals, boneless beef, canned or preserved meat and poultry products, other processed meat products, processed or frozen seafood, and hides and skins. It is to note that for items 49 "Meat Products" and 55 "Food of Animal Origin other than Meat Products Prescribed in MOPH Notification No. 243/2544 (2001)", the Thai FDA accepts FSIS Form 9060-5 as equivalent to the certificate of free sale.

In addition, both the DOA and the DLD require import permits. The procedure of import permit

issuance has been, at times, non-transparent for certain pork and poultry products. The DLD agreed in principle (without official writing) to accept a "system audit" instead of its earlier requirement of "individual plan audit". However, the DLD added the requirement that exporting countries of animal and animal products must complete the DLD's questionnaires for approval before the DLD send its team to conduct on-site inspection in each exporting country.
