Post: Ankara Turkey Eliminates Some Feedstuff Import Tariffs

Report Highlights:

Turkey reduced the import tariff on Brans under HS code 2302 from 5 percent to 0 percent according to a governmental decree. Turkey also rearranged the import tariff on some commodities under HS code 2306 with the same decree, reducing the tariff from 13.5 percent to 6.5 percent on condition that the commodity is used as feed.

General Information:

In the scope of measures against food inflation, the Government of Turkey (GOT) announced some tariff reductions on feed materials. The GOT reduced the import tariff on all bran varieties from five percent to zero according to a decree published in the Official Gazette on November 22, 2017. Although some oilseed meals' tariffs, starting with HS code 2306, have not been updated, a 6.5 percent tariff will be implemented if they are used as feedstuff.

Commodities under HS code 23, such as meals and brans, are increasingly popular in the feed sector (See Tables 1-2 below) due to high nutritional content, relatively low duty tax, and a competitive price in recent years. According to the Turkish Statistical Institute, from September 2016 to August 2017, Turkey imported 1.6 million metric tons (MMT) of wheat bran which is subject to 5 percent tariff. Main suppliers were Russia (587,000 MT), Ukraine (430,000 MT) and Italy (125,000 MT). Turkey imported about 1 MMT of sunflower seed meal in the same period. Main suppliers were Russia (477,000 MT) and Ukraine (360,000 MT). With the current tariff elimination, it is expected that strong demand from the feed industry for meals and brans will continue.
