September 2020

The September WASDE report shows FY 2020 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 83,047 short tons raw value (STRV), up 22,046 from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The FY 2021 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall is projected at 99,208 STRV. No information is available about specific countries.

On September 10, USDA increased the FY 2020 WTO raw sugar TRQ by 90,718 MTRV. USDA also extended the entry period by 1 month to October 31, 2020.

On July 1, 2020, USTR announced Canada's CY 2020 TRQs for refined beet sugar (4,800 mt); refined raw sugar (36,287 mt); and sugar-containing products (4,800 mt) under the USMCA.
