Report Highlights:

On January 1, 2026, the Government of Morocco (GOM) published Circular # 6705/222, announcing the required tariff changes under the U.S.-Morocco Free Trade Agreement (FTA) for Calendar Year 2026. The circular includes tariffs, tariff-rate quotas (TRQs), tariff-rate quota administration, and agricultural safeguard measures. In 2026, Morocco continues to apply additional safeguard measures for frozen or chilled chicken legs and wings. In Morocco's 2026 Finance Law, Morocco suspended import tariffs on livestock as a targeted measure to stabilize domestic meat supply and local prices.

Summary

On January 1, 2026, the Government of Morocco (GOM) published Circular #6705/222, announcing tariff changes as required under the U.S.-Morocco Free Trade Agreement (FTA) for calendar year 2026. The circular includes tariffs, tariff-rate quotas (TRQs), tariff-rate quota administration, agricultural safeguard measures.

Circular highlights include:

- 1) Annex IV-A: Agricultural Tariff Quotas for the period January 1st to December 31, 2026.
- 2) Additional duty to be applied as part of the implementation of agricultural safeguard measures (MSA) for the period from January 1 to December 31, 2026 (Annex V) for frozen, fresh or chilled chicken legs and wings.

In Morocco's [2026 Finance Law](#), Morocco suspended import duties on livestock as a targeted measure to stabilize local prices and domestic meat supply. This measure removes customs duties on the importation of live bovine animals (300,000 head) and camelids (10,000 head) from all origins until December 31, 2026.

In 2025, industry sources told Post the United States filled the standard beef quota for the first time.
