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Report Highlights:

Japan's Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF) proposed 13 new geographical indications (GIs) for EU food products. MAFF is accepting public comments on the proposal through November 4, 2025.

General Information

On August 1, 2025, Japan's Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF) opened a public comment period for 13 newly proposed geographical indications (GIs) for food products from the European Union (EU). The list includes six types of cheese, three types of meat products, two types of fruits, raisins, and oil. The comment period will close on November 4, 2025, and all comments must be submitted in Japanese. After the comment period ends, MAFF will convene an expert committee meeting and make the final determination of the GI status of these products.
