Report Highlights:

The Angolan Agricultural Economic Fact Sheet has been updated to include calendar year 2022. U.S. agricultural exports to Angola reached \$237 million in 2022, rebounding by 80 percent from the previous year. American food and agricultural exports to Angola are dominated by frozen poultry, which accounts for 97 percent of total trade, followed by 1 percent each for beef livers and frozen bovine meat, respectively.


General


- Angola is Africa's eight largest economy in Africa.
- Angola is one of the largest oil producers in Africa.
- Crude oil represents approximately 94% of Angola's total exports.
- Agriculture accounts for 9.5% of Angola's US\$121.4 billion GDP.
- Angola has the resources to become one of the leading agricultural countries in Africa as its diverse ecology provides an environment capable of hosting a rich variety of crops and livestock.
- Currently, Angola only cultivates approximately 10% of its 58 million hectares of agricultural land available.
- Family farms continue to dominate the agricultural sector, accounting for 91.5 percent of the sown area, 91.1 percent of the harvested area and 82.5 percent of the volume of agricultural products produced in the country.


- Prior to the 1975-2002 civil war, Angola was a major exporter of coffee, sisal, sugar cane, banana, cotton, and self-sufficient in all food crops except wheat. The civil war disrupted agricultural production and displaced millions of people.
- Some estimates say Angola currently imports more than half of its food.
- Angola was the sixth largest market for U.S. frozen poultry and the fourth largest market for frozen chicken leg quarters in 2022.




















US-Angola Agricultural Trade
