

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2021

July 2021

The July WASDE report shows FY 2021 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 86,854 short tons raw value (STRV), down 60,000 STRV from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The FY 2022 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall is projected at 99,208 STRV. No information is available about specific countries.

On July 9, USTR reallocated 76,571 metric tons raw value (MTRV) of the original WTO raw sugar TRQ quantity from those countries that have stated they do not intend to fill their FY 2021 allocated raw sugar quantities (see Table 3B).

On July 9, USDA increased the FY 2021 specialty sugar TRQ by 40,000 MTRV. Entry of this sugar opens on July 21, 2021.
