Report Highlights:

The General Administration of Customs of the People's Republic of China (GACC) Department of Animal and Plant Quarantine (DAPQ) published updated lists of exporters eligible to ship U.S. feed and feed additive products on September 20, 2023. The update included 6 feed additives products, 1 single cell product, 2 mixed feed ingredient products, and 16 compound feed products. U.S. facilities and exporters with questions about registering their facility can contact AgBeijing@usda.gov for additional guidance and information on registrations or updating registrations.

The General Administration of Customs of the People's Republic of China (GACC) Department of Animal and Plant Quarantine (DAPQ) published updated lists of exporters eligible to ship U.S. feed and feed additive products on September 20, 2023. The update included 6 feed additives products, 1 single cell product, 2 mixed feed ingredient products, and 16 compound feed products.

U.S. producers of feed and feed additives products must register with GACC before shipping products to China to avoid potential issues upon import. After successful registration, updated feed facility and product lists are published on the GACC website (<u>http://dzs.customs.gov.cn/</u>).

U.S. facilities and exporters should work closely with their importers in China to ensure their firms and products are listed on <u>GACC website</u> before shipment of any feed and feed additive products.
