Report Highlights:

The Government of Morocco has released its final wheat and barley production numbers for the 2022 crop, including 1.89 MMT of common wheat, 0.81 MMT of durum wheat, and 0.7 MMT of barley. The MY2022/23 wheat and barley harvest was down 67 percent compared to previous season due to severe drought. The government of Morocco will continue to support wheat imports based on a fixed flat-rate premium through December 31, 2022.

General Information

Production Update

The Government of Morocco has released its <u>final</u> wheat and barley production numbers for the 2022 crop, including 1.89 MMT of common wheat, 0.81 MMT of durum wheat, and 0.7 MMT of barley. The MY2022/23 wheat and barley harvest were down 67 percent compared to previous season due to severe drought. Post adjusts MY2022/23 production numbers for wheat and barley based on Morocco's final official numbers.

Policy

The Government of Morocco continues to support bread wheat imports based on a fixed flat-rate premium in response to rising wheat prices. The baseline price is calculated every <u>two weeks</u> and is based on prices assessed from four origins (Black Sea, France, Argentina, and the United States). The current restitution system is valid until December 31, 2022.

Trade Update

In MY 2021/22 Morocco has turned to South America (Argentina and Brazil) to meet its wheat supply, while wheat imports from Ukraine and Russia are down 46% and 85%, respectively. Post revises its MY and TY barley numbers for 2020/21 and 2021/22 based on trade to date data.
