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## **Report Highlights:**

This report provides updates to the Korean 2020 Rice Production report released by FAS/Seoul on November 18, 2020, based on new data released by the Ministry of Agriculture, Food, and Rural Affairs (MAFRA) in December 2020. FAS/Seoul's 2020 rice production estimate remains unchanged at 3.5 million metric tons (MMT), with a projected 1.7 percent increase in demand over the previous estimate. Korean rice prices increased in late 2020 and early 2021 due to lower overall production in 2020, increasing pressure on the government to release rice stocks and increase imports.

#### RICE

### **Executive Summary**

- FAS/Seoul's rice production estimate remains unchanged from the previous report: 3.5 million metric tons (MMT).
- Rice demand in MY 2020 increased by 1.7 percent from the previous Post estimate, to 4.65 MMT.
- In MY 2019/20, Korea imported 465,609 metric tons (MT) of rice, composed of 390,700 MT imported under the 2019 TRQ and 74,909 MT imported under the 2020 TRQ. The remaining balance of the 2020 TRQ will be imported in MY 2020/21.
- Total MY 2020/21 imports are expected to reach 500,000 MT (including some portion of the 2021 TRQ).
- Reduced domestic rice production in 2020 triggered prices to increase by 14-20 percent from October through December over the same period last year, increasing the appeal of imports.

#### **RICE PRODUCTION**

Production remains unchanged (at 3,506,578 MT) from the 2020 Rice Production Update.

#### RICE CONSUMPTION

In December 2020, the Korean Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (MAFRA) released preliminary rice consumption data for MY 2018/19 in the MAFRA statistical yearbook. Total rice demand in the marketing year increased to 4.65 MMT, up 1.7 percent from the previous Post estimate, due to a large bump in the 'Other and Loss' category. MAFRA uses the 'Other and Loss' category to adjust for statistical errors over the course of the year. Other categories, such as table rice and processing rice, declined by 2.1 percent from the previous year due to a sharp drop in rice use for animal feed (Table 1).

## **RICE TRADE**

At the end of 2019 the Korean government agreed to a compromise with the five countries who had raised concerns in the WTO with Korea's rice tariff schedule. As part of this compromise, Korea agreed to allocate 408,700 MT of the WTO TRQ among the five countries as below. Within the rice TRQ, Korea established a country-specific quota (CSQ) for each of the five parties and allocated the following volumes on a milled rice basis:

United States: 132,304 MT

China: 157,195 MT

Vietnam: 55,112 MT Thailand: 28,494 MT Australia: 15,595 MT

Through the plurilateral agreement, which took effect in January 2020, Korea has made the remaining 20,000 MT (milled) of the rice WTO TRQ available on a Most-Favored Nation (MFN) basis to all WTO members.

As of December 17, 2020, Korea completed purchasing of 408,700 MT under the 2020 TRQ, 160,995 MT of which was delivered in the second half of CY 2020 (May-December) on a contract basis and 247,705 MT of which is scheduled for delivery in CY 2021 (January-June) (Table 9 & 10).

In MY 2019/20, Korea imported 465,609 MT of rice, composed of 390,700 MT imported under the 2019 TRQ and 74,909 MT imported under the 2020 TRQ. The remaining balance of the 2020 TRQ will be imported in MY 2020/21, with total MY 2020/21 imports expected to reach 500,000 MT as some parts of the 2021 TRQ are imported in MY 2020/21.

## 2020 Rice TRQ Tendering Results:

On December 17, 2020, the Korea Agro-Fisheries and Food Trade Corporation (aT) completed the tendering process for 2020 rice TRQ commitments. Korea purchased a total of 408,700 MT of rice (milled basis) from five countries: the United States, China, Vietnam, Thailand, and India. The U.S. share was 32.4 percent, down 0.4 percentage points from the previous year under CSQ fulfilment (Table 5). Contracts for U.S. rice totaled 132,304 MT (milled), worth \$130.4 million. Of this total, 104,227 MT was brown rice (equivalent to 93,804 MT on a milled basis) used for food processing purposes, and the remaining 38,500 MT was milled rice for table use (Table 7).

Under the 2020 rice TRQ, the Korean government purchased 40,000 MT of imported USDA # 1 grade milled rice for table use. This total consisted of 38,500 MT of medium grain rice from the United States and 1,500 MT of long grain rice from Thailand.

The average contracted price for U.S. #1 medium grain table rice was \$985.29/MT, (based on Cost Insurance and Freight (CIF) rates). This was a 2.2 percent increase over the previous year. Meanwhile, Thai #1 long grain table rice was contracted at \$575.00/MT, (CIF), up 15.2 percent from the previous year's price for Vietnamese rice.

#### **Auctions for Imported Table Rice:**

aT distributes table rice shipments to the consumer market through a public auction system. Processing rice is distributed to end-users, such as food processors and alcoholic beverage producers, by MAFRA at a set price throughout the year.

Since 2013, Korea's consistent overproduction of rice has led to high stock volumes and subsequently slowed the pace of auctions for imported rice for table use. As a result, Korea's annual volume of auctioned rice has decreased. Additionally, as large rice stocks have led to low domestic prices, Korean farmers have petitioned the government to slow auctions for imported table rice and, during the harvest season, stop auctions for imported medium and short grain rice altogether.

Furthermore, the slow pace of auctioning has led to a deterioration in the quality of government-stored rice and a loss of marketability., Unsold portions of stored rice are being utilized for alcohol processing. Under the 2015 TRQ 52,959 MT (34,035 MT of U.S. medium grain) and under 2016 TRQ 23,690 MT (23,084 MT of U.S. medium grain) was converted for processing use.

As of January 6, 2020, aT stopped auctioning U.S. medium grain rice imported in the first half of 2018 under the 2017 TRQ. The unsold portion of 13,546 MT to be converted to alcohol processing (Table 13).

As of December 30, 2020, aT stopped auctioning U.S. medium grain rice imported in the first half of 2019 under 2018 TRQ, expecting the unsold portion of 12,101 MT to be converted to alcohol or food processing (Table 14).

As of January 4, 2021, aT started auctioning U.S. medium grain rice imported under the 2019 TRQ, which was delivered in the first half of 2020. Vietnamese long grain rice was auctioned starting in June 2020, with 73 percent of total imports already sold as of early 2021. (Table 15).

Korea's 2019/20 rice exports are estimated at 55,083 MT of domestically produced rice, including both food aid and commercial exports. In 2020 Korea donated 2,954 MT of rice (milled) to the Philippines (2,354MT) and Myanmar (600MT) under the ASEAN Plus Three Emergency Rice Reserve (APTERR) after natural disasters struck both countries. Under the Food Assistance Convention (FAC), Korea shipped 50,000 MT of 2018 domestic rice crop (milled) to four countries in Africa and the Middle East in May 2020: 19,000 MT to Yemen, 16,000 MT to Ethiopia, 10,000 MT to Kenya, and 5,000 MT to Uganda. The remaining 2,242 MT was exported through commercial channels.



## **Rice Marketing:**

Lower rice production in 2020 triggered rice market prices to increase by 14-20 percent from October through December over the same period in the previous year. To counter rising prices, Korea decided to release 370,000 MT of government-held rice stock to curb rising rice market prices in the months following the rice harvest. Under the government rice distribution plan, the first batch released was 176,000 MT: 76,000 MT of 2020 crop for table rice from January on, 40,000 MT of 2018 crop for processing in January, and 60,000 MT of 2019 crop for processing in February. The remaining 190,000 MT will be released from March through June 2021 based on the rice market situation.

### **RICE STOCKS**

MY 2020/21 ending stocks (by the end of October 2021) are revised up to 1.1 MMT, or 28.5 percent of total consumption, increasing 1.2 percentage point from the previous forecast with slightly lower total consumption expected.

The 2019/20 ending stock forecast (by the end of October 2020) remains unchanged at 1.13 MMT, or 27.9 percent of total consumption.

MY 2018/19 ending stock is revised down to 1.02 MMT, or 21.8 percent of total consumption following a 1.7 percent (to 4.65 MMT) increase in consumption based on the preliminary rice supply and demand data issued by MAFRA in December 2020.
