Japan Notifies WTO of Revised Monepantel Residue Standards

Report Highlights:

On March 27, 2019, Japan notified the World Trade Organization of draft amendments to the maximum residue levels (MRL) for the veterinary drug, Monepantel, via G/SPS/N/JPN/626. Japan adopted these MRLs on January 22, 2019. There will be no public comment period established for this proposal as this proposal relaxes the regulation. However, interested U.S. parties are welcomed to share their comments and/or concerns with USDA's enquiry point (us.spsenquirypoint@fas.usda.gov).

General Information:

On March 27, 2019, Japan notified the World Trade Organization of draft amendments to the maximum residue levels (MRL) for the veterinary drug, Monepantel, via <u>G/SPS/N/JPN/626</u>. - 1. "Other terrestrial mammals" refers to all terrestrial mammals, except cattle and pig.
- 2. "Edible offal" refers to all edible parts, except muscle, fat, liver, and kidney.

^{*} The uniform limit 0.01 ppm is applied to commodities for which renewed MRLs are not given in this table and to commodities not listed above.
