Report Highlights:

Rice export prices increased 2 percent despite the weakening of the Thai baht.

Export prices of most grades of rice increased 2 percent despite the weakening of the Thai baht to 35.49 baht/\$1.00 from the previous week's exchange rate of 34.98 baht/\$1.00. The weakening of the Thai baht helped boost Thai rice export competitiveness. Strong demand from Middle Eastern countries, especially for white rice, put upward pressure on export prices of Thai rice. The Ministry of Commerce is looking for opportunities to expand Thai rice exports to other potential markets in the Middle East and North Africa regions.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for June 20 - 26, 2022, totaled 156,142 metric tons, up 29,651 metric tons from the previous week and up 31,523 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 124,619 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – June 26, 2022, totaled 2,801,461 metric tons, up 76 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
