Report Highlights:

Export prices increased 1-2 percent due to the strengthening of the Thai baht.

Export prices of all grades of rice increased 1 - 2 percent from the previous week as the Thai baht strengthened to 34.44 baht/\$1.00 from the previous week's exchange rate of 34.68 baht/\$1.00. Steady demand from ASEAN countries also contributed to the increase in export and domestic prices. Rice traders and millers expect that MY2022/23 off-season rice production will be higher than MY2021/22 off-season rice production with abundant water supplies in major reservoirs helping to increase yields.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for December 12 - 18, 2022, totaled 162,998 metric tons, up 32,007 metric tons from the previous week and up 30,333 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 132,665 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – December 18, 2022, totaled 6,214,329 metric tons, up 38 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
