Export prices of all grades of rice declined 1-2 percent from the previous week due to a further weakening of the Thai baht to 34.95 baht/\$1.00, the lowest exchange rate in 9 weeks, from the previous week's exchange rate of 34.29 baht/\$1.00. Even though new supplies of MY2022/23 off-season rice continue entering the market, domestic prices of white and parboiled rice slightly rose as exporters are seeking white and parboiled rice to fulfil their contracted shipments.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for February 13 - 19, 2023, totaled 94,909 metric tons, up 18,722 metric tons from the previous week and down 8,229 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 103,138 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 - 19, 2023, totaled 744,286 metric tons, down 14.8 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
