Export prices of most grades of rice decreased one percent from the previous week despite the strengthening of the Thai baht. The Thai baht strengthened to 34.32 baht/\$1.00 from the previous week's exchange rate of 34.38 baht/\$1.00. Domestic rice prices, both farm-gate and retail prices, also decreased one percent from the previous week as local millers reportedly had enough off-season rice in stock.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for May 29 – June 4, 2023, totaled 102,358 metric tons, metric tons down 57,634 from the previous week and down 36,141 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 138,499 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – June 4, 2023, totaled 2,672,018 metric tons, up 11.4 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
