Export prices of most grades of rice increased one percent from the previous week due to continued demand for Thai rice and attractive prices. Thai white rice prices were \$3-10/MT lower than Vietnamese rice prices, compared to Thai white rice prices typically being \$15-25/MT higher than Vietnamese rice. Domestic rice prices also increased one percent from the previous week. The Thai baht, however, further weakened to 35.09 baht/\$1.00 from the previous week's exchange rate of 34.62 baht/\$1.00.

## **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for June 12 - 18, 2023, totaled 103,974 metric tons, up 4,446 metric tons from the previous week and down 12,489 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 116,463 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – June 18, 2023, totaled 2,875,019 metric tons, up 8.8 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
