Despite the weakening of the Thai baht to 34.75 baht/\$1.00 from 34.07 baht/\$1.00 in the previous week, export prices for all grades of rice further increased 3-6 percent due to the panic buying from foreign buyers. Thai rice export prices have increased by around \$120/MT since the Indian government imposed an export ban of non-basmati rice on July 20, 2023. Also, domestic rice prices were under upward pressure as local mills reportedly secured rice supplies to build up their inventories and to fulfill contracted shipments.

## **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for July 24 - 30, 2023, totaled 124,610 metric tons, up 1,922 metric tons from the previous week and up 284 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 124,325 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 - July 30, 2023, totaled 3,627,916 metric tons, up 6.2 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
