Report Highlights:

Export rice prices fell by 1-3 percent as the Thai baht weakened and new paddy rice crop entered the market.

Export rice prices dropped 1-3 percent from the previous week as the supplies of MY2023/24 new-crop paddy rice continued to enter the market. The farm-gate prices of paddy rice further declined 3-4 percent from the previous week. Export prices of Thai fragrant rice dropped the most at 3 percent from previous week as supplies of main-crop fragrant rice entered the market, especially in the northeastern region. Furthermore, the Thai baht weakened to \$1.00=35.92 baht from the previous week's exchange rate of \$1.00=35.33 baht.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for October 30 – November 5, 2023, totaled 163,905 metric tons, down 7,731 metric tons from the previous week and up 1,877 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 162,028 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to November 5, 2023, totaled 5,571,490 metric tons, up 3.6 percent compared to the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
