Report Highlights:

Rice export prices dropped 2-3 percent as the Thai baht weakened and new MY 2023/24 off-season rice supplies entered the market.

Export prices of all grades of rice dropped 2-3 percent from the previous week due to the weakening of the Thai baht and the downward pressure from new supplies of off-season rice. The Thai baht weakened to \$1.00=35.78 baht from the previous week's exchange rate of \$1.00=35.30 baht. As MY 2023/24 off-season rice entered the market, the farm-gate prices of white paddy rice fell to 11,290 baht per metric ton (\$315/MT) this week, down 4 percent from the previous week.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for March 4 - 10, 2024, totaled 148,534 metric tons, up 154 metric tons from the previous week and up 4,055 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 144,479 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to March 10, 2024, totaled 1,603,188 metric tons, up 52 percent compared to the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
