Report Highlights:

Rice export prices increased 2-4 percent due to the strengthening of the Thai baht and strong export demands for Thai rice.

Thai rice export prices increased 2-4 percent from the previous week as the Thai baht strengthened to \$1.00=34.27 baht from the previous week's exchange rate of \$1.00=34.99 baht. Strong export demands for white rice from main markets such as ASEAN countries and Africa also boosted Thai rice exports. At the same time, domestic rice prices dropped one percent as new supplies of off-season rice from the central plains continued to enter the market.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for August 5 - 11, 2024, totaled 186,044 metric tons, up 57,547 metric tons from the previous week and up 50,790 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 135,254 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to August 11, 2024, totaled 5,156,281 metric tons, up 34 percent compared to the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
