The Vietnam Food Association (VFA) suggested a new Minimum Export Price (MEP) last week for 25 percent broken rice at \$350 per ton. Rice price offers from exporters decreased slightly last week, due to unfavorable responses from international buyers.

Paddy prices dropped last week due to the pressure of the harvested Spring crop paddy in the Mekong River Delta.
