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## **Report Highlights:**

Export prices of white and parboiled rice decreased 2-3 percent due to the further weakening of the Thai baht against the U.S. dollar.

Export prices of white and parboiled rice decreased 2-3 percent due mainly to the further weakening of the Thai baht to 31.97 baht/U.S. \$1.00 from the previous week's exchange rate of 31.87 baht/U.S. \$1.00. Most new inquires this week were for parboiled rice from African countries. Container shortages are still a main concern for rice exporters, causing a delay in shipment and doubling fright costs. Local rice mills are holding large inventories of paddy rice due to slow exports, while MY2020/21 off-season rice harvesting is nearly completed.

## **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for June 28 – July 4, 2021, totaled 43,444 metric tons, down 41,787 metric tons from the previous week and down 26,879 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 70,323 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – July 4, 2021, totaled 1,640,160 metric tons, down 23 percent from the same period last year.

**Note on data:** Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013 and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
