Rice export increased 3 percent due mainly from the further strengthening of the Thai baht. The Thai baht strengthened to 29.82 baht/U.S. \$1.00 from the seven-year record exchange rate of 29.92 baht/U.S. \$1.00 in the previous week. New inquiries for Thai rice remain quiet due to a lack of available containers, which has caused shipping delays.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for December 7-13, 2020, totaled 100,297 metric tons, up 57,959 metric tons from the previous week and up 26,131 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 74,166 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – December 13, 2020, totaled 4,038,962 metric tons, down 28 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013 and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
