Rice Imports First Quarter 2010

Report Highlights:

Senegal rice imports in the first quarter of 2010 decreased considerably (32.5 percent) compared to the last quarter of 2009 (124,806 MT versus 184,824 MT). Broken rice remains the most preferred rice imported in Senegal with more than 99 percent of the market share. Thailand remains the largest rice supplier in the country with 44 percent of the market share followed by Vietnam (27 percent) and Brazil (9 percent). There were no arrivals from the U.S. this quarter.

Executive Summary:

Senegal's rice imports in the first quarter 2010 reached 124,806 MT representing a decrease of 28.4 percent compared to the first quarter 2009 as well as a decline of 32.5 compared to the last quarter of 2009 (See Table 1), most likely owing to increased supplies and access to local rice.

Practically all rice imported is broken rice, mostly supplied by Thailand and Vietnam (*See Table 3*). However, among the export countries, Thailand remains the largest supplier with 44 percent of the market share followed by Vietnam (27 percent) and Brazil (9 percent) (*See Table 2*).

This first quarter, Senegal did not import U.S. rice. The preference between semi- or whole milled rice packaged in bags weighting more than 5 kilos was almost the same as the one packaged in less than 5 kilos. (see Table 3)
