Report Highlights:

Taiwan released its list of imported food and agricultural products undergoing enhanced border inspection for 2023. No U.S. products were included on the list. In 2022, U.S. apples, avocados, and paper plates had been subject to enhanced inspection.

General Information:

The Taiwan Food and Drug Administration (TFDA) published its annual list of imported food and agricultural products subject to enhanced border inspection for 2023. No U.S. products were included on the list.

In 2022, three U.S. products (fresh apple, fresh avocado, and paper plates) had received enhanced border inspection. These products will return to TFDA's normal border inspection rate for importers in good standing, which is two to ten percent.
