Report Highlights:

All U.S. fresh blueberries and onions entering Taiwan will be subject to enhanced inspections in calendar year 2020.





The Taiwan Food and Drug Administration (TFDA) has published the updated enhanced inspection list for food imports in calendar year 2020. Designated products from specified countries on the list are subject to a heightened 20 to 50 percent import inspection rate before quarantine clearance. Effective January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020, all U.S. origin fresh blueberry and onions will be subject to enhanced inspection rates when entering Taiwan. TFDA removed U.S. lettuce from the enhanced inspection list. The full list of countries and tariff codes is available on the <u>TFDA website</u>.
