Export prices of white rice increased one percent from the previous week despite the weakening of the Thai baht to 33.43 baht/\$1.00 from the previous week's exchange rate of 33.24 baht/\$1.00. Rice exporters are actively seeking new-crop rice supplies to fulfill their contracted shipments of white and parboiled rice.

The Bank for Agriculture and Agricultural Cooperatives provided compensation payments under the MY2021/22 Paddy Rice Price Guarantee Program to farmers who harvested a main rice crop between October 1 and December 9, 2021, totaling 82,308 million baht (\$2,462 billion), covering 4.5 million households as market prices were lower than the guaranteed prices.

## **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for December 6-12, 2021, totaled 90,905 metric tons, down 118 metric tons from the previous week and down 20,493 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 111,398 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to December 12, 2021, totaled 4,383,073 metric tons, up 9 percent from the same period last year.



Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
