Description of content: Amendment of pesticide MRLs of Acynonapyr, Alanycarb, Chlormequat, Cyantraniliprole, Cyprodinil, Cyromazine, Fluazaindolizine, Fludioxonil, Fluoxapiprolin, Indoxacarb, Mandipropamid, Oxathiapiprolin, Pydiflumetofen, Tefuryltrione, Triafamone in fruits, vegetables, cereal grains, tree nuts and herbs. Amendment of Noni fruit classified in the group of Large berries and Perilla flower classified in the group of herbs.

Amendment of pesticide MRLs of Cypermethrin, Deltamethrin, Ethiprole, Fenitrothion, Fluxapyroxad, Metconazole, Permethrin, Phosmet, Propargite and Quinoxyfen in livestock and poultry tissue, edible offal, egg, and milk.
